A message from Mr Wright



Good afternoon everyone

I hope that you and your families are all well. I am keeping the newsletter short this week due to the amount you already have had to read about the phased reopening of school. I would like to say how much we are looking forward to seeing some of the children return in the coming days and weeks, although school won't feel quite the same until we have every child back attending when it is safe to do so.

Thank you for your patience and understanding with the last minute postponement of our planned reopening earlier in the week. I am so pleased that Public Health England have advised it is now safe to proceed.

I would like to underline how important it is that all parents of those children returning check the start and finish times for their children's classes. We now have a staggered system that allows children to arrive and leave in their bubbles and maintain social distancing on the playground / waiting areas.

It is also vital that parents and children follow the one-way system when entering and exiting the school site. This will be in operation in the mornings for drop-off and in the afternoons for collection. All parents and children must enter through the Clough Avenue gates and exit via Fisher Avenue.
